David Ramey is on a very short list of California's most gifted winemakers. During his tenures at Chalk Hill, Dominus and Rudd, David elevated his employers' wines to critical stardom and demonstrated equal mastery of red *and* white varietals. Parker has given a laundry list of his wines eye-popping scores and *Wine Spectator* ran a feature on him appropriately entitled "The Master's Touch." He has universal respect among both critics and the winemaking community and (unlike a few high-profile prima donnas) is a genuine class act. The man just makes great wine and leaves the attitude at the cellar door.

After starting his own label a few years back, David initially focused on Chardonnay. His single-vineyard Hyde and Hudson offerings instantly rocketed him to the upper echelon of producers with wines garnering upwards of 97-point reviews from the major wine press. He hasn't missed a beat in successive years. The '01 vintage marks his first release of "big reds" under his own label, and fans of David's wares are understandably thrilled. These are absolutely pristine examples of what can happen when world-class fruit lands in the right cellar.

2001 Diamond Mountain Young Vines Proprietary Red Wine: The dense ruby/purple-colored 2001 Diamond Mountain Young Vines Proprietary Red is a seamless, lush offering displaying notes of creosote, melted licorice, black currants, and blackberries. It is medium to full-bodied and soft, with low acidity. This is a sexy red to enjoy over the next 10-15 years. – *Robert Parker – Wine Advocate Issue #142*

This blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, and Cabernet Franc boasts an opaque purple color followed by aromas of licorice, blueberries, creme de cassis, tar, and subtle new oak. It is dense, rich, and full-bodied, with multiple layers, low acidity, and high levels of glycerin as well as extract. – *Robert Parker – Wine Advocate Issue #142*
